

## Remarks by Dr. Nancy Chapman

Event: ACUCA-SU-United-Board Joint Consultation

Greetings! I'm Nancy Chapman, President of the United Board for Christian Higher Education in Asia. On behalf of the United Board, I welcome you to this gathering on the theme "Envisioning Christian Higher Education: Our Preferred Futures". This event is being hosted by Silliman University. To President Betty Cernol-McCann and her colleagues at Silliman, and to everyone associated with ACUCA, as well as the organizing committee for this conference, we express our warm appreciation for all that you have done to bring us together.

The theme of this event is especially timely given all of the disruptions, changes and adaptations forced on our colleges, universities and societies by the COVID-19 pandemic. Higher education continues to face extraordinary challenges brought on by, or accelerated by the pandemic. There's no question that it will emerge from this crisis significantly changed.
